Competed at Round 3 of the Victorian State circuit racing titles on the June long weekend. Against Maserati Ghibli, Porsche GT2, Ferrari 360's, Robnell Cobra's, TR8 Triumph and lots of other exotic machinery, I managed to qualify 6th on the grid (5th place went the Chris Barry in his PRB Birkin).

First race was red flagged due to big accident on start line (grid behind us)

Second race Sunday morning (Full wet race, typical Phillip Island weather) regrided 6th. Finished race in 6th position.

Third Race. Griding 6th. Finished race 6th. Managed to get a good start and get into third place into first corner, but bigger cars have more power to get us on the straights. Finished behind Maserati, Robnell Cobra, Porsche GT2, TR8 Triumph, PRB Birkin, then myself.

First race that was red-flagged was re-run, but had a leaking radiator that we fixed, a puncture that was repaired, but wasn't able to get fuel the the engine (rubbish in the fuel pump).

*At the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the SDMA all positions on the committee become vacant. Nominations to fill the committee positions are sought from club members at the AGM.*

*A strong and vital committee is important to the continued growth of the SDMA and motorsport in the ACT. Please take the time to read the roles of office bearers and consider a position suitable to your skills and abilities.*

*The main office bearers in the Club have important roles, which ensure the SDMA continues to be a success.*

### **President:**

*The President plays a crucial role and this function can be the most entertaining and satisfying of all the roles. The President must ensure the SDMA meetings run smoothly by leading discussion and ensuring speakers are not repetitious or stray from the topics. It is the President's role to offer a balanced discussion and summarise points of view before asking members to vote.*

*The President must be reasonably easy to contact at work and at home, be able to get along with people and have a genuine commitment to the long-term interests of the club.*

### **Duties:**

- General club and committee meeting
- Provide policy direction and advice
- Allocate resources to club projects
- Oversee the organisation of club activities
- Contact point for club members, CAMS, government agencies and members of the public

### **Vice President:**

*The Vice President's role is to assist the President.*

### **Duties:**

- Chair meetings in the absence of the President
- Assist the President with other duties as requested

### **Secretary:**

*The Secretary is the linchpin of the SDMA. The Secretary's basic roles are to keep records of the organisation, to deal with the correspondence and administration. The Secretary files all paperwork required by CAMS for events. The Secretary also liaises with many other agencies and networks about track hire, noise credits and current issues.*

### **Duties:**

- Organise and keep up to date club records and files
- File paperwork required by CAMS for club events
- Clear the club mailbox regularly

- Attend meetings
- In consultation with the President, deal with club correspondence

**Assistant Secretary:**

The Assistant Secretary assists the Secretary as requested. The Assistant Secretary sends out agendas for meetings and takes the minutes of club and committee meetings.

Duties:

- Send out club and committee meeting agendas
- Take minutes at club and committee meetings
- Forward minutes to committee members and Magazine Editor

**Public Officer:**

This position is a legal requirement and is the government contact point.

**Treasurer:**

The Treasurer is responsible for managing the finances of the club.

Duties:

- Banking
- Writing cheques
- GST and BAS
- Balancing of the club's books
- Liaise with the ATO and accountant
- Ensure club finances are audited in a timely manner
- Ensure any government grants are acquitted and papers lodged in a timely manner
- Liaise with grant bodies

**Club Captain:**

The Club Captain is responsible for reporting on club events and for calculating point scores for the ACT championship and the SDMA club person awards.

Duties:

- Liaise with competitors and calculate point scores for both awards
- Report on events held by the club and other relevant events which have been attended by members

**Publicity Officer:**

The Publicity Officer is responsible for bringing the club and its activities to the notice of the public and other organisations, using the print, radio and television media.

Duties:

- Promote awareness of the club
- Promote awareness of club events and activities

**Magazine Editor:**

The Editor is responsible for the production and distribution of the Club's monthly magazine "Over the hill and round the bend".

Duties:

- Produce a quality publication which includes information on club meetings, events, membership and minutes of previous meetings
- Prepare magazine within a time frame that enables the printing and distribution of the magazine prior to each monthly club meeting
- Arrange for the printing and postage of hard copies of magazine and email electronic copies.

**Membership Secretary:**

The Membership Secretary is responsible for the membership records and renewals.

Duties:

- Maintain up to date membership forms
- Distribute membership forms as required
- Receive completed membership/renewal forms and payments for membership
- Maintain membership records
- Issue membership cards
- Update Magazine Editor on membership mailing list

John said the test and tune day went exceptionally well. #### **General business**

1. Andrew O said he had noted a decrease in members attending meetings. There was general discussion about recent club meetings. Many members felt they were less social and enjoyable.
